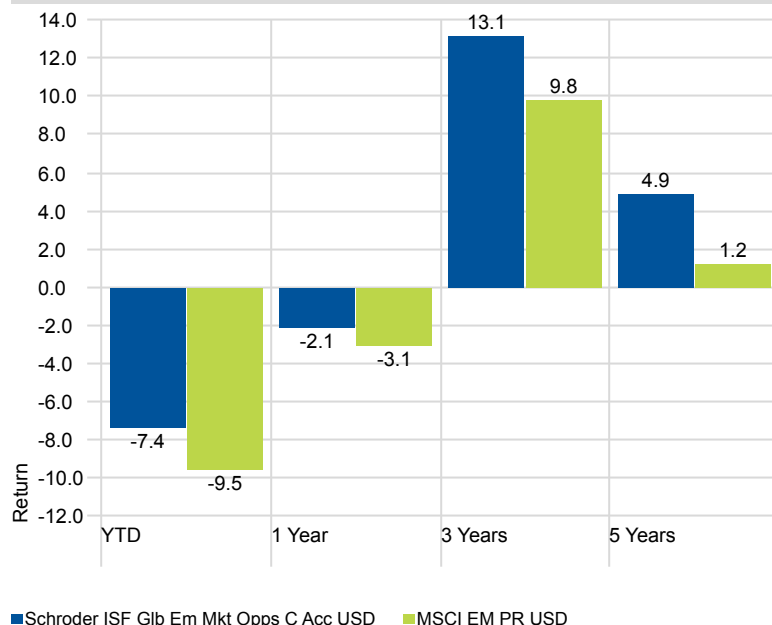


Benchmark: MSCI EM PR USD

Investment Strategy

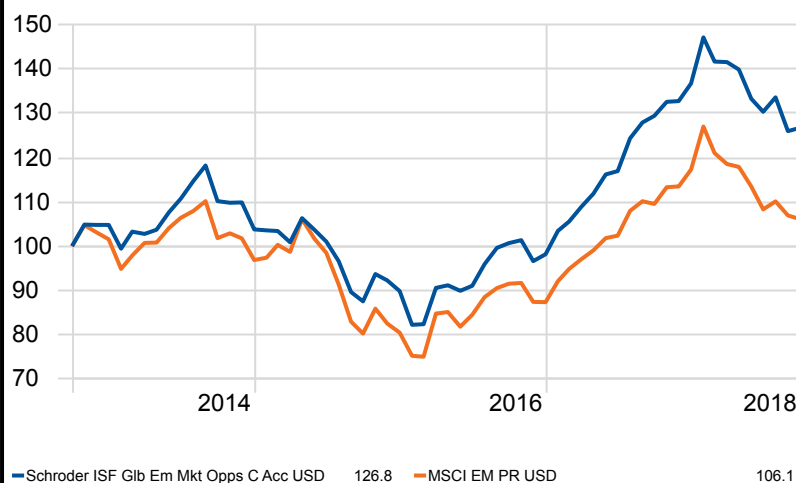
The fund aims to provide capital growth and income by investing in equity and equity related securities of companies in emerging market countries worldwide. The fund invests at least two-thirds of its assets in equity and equity related securities of companies in emerging market countries worldwide. The fund may invest up to 40% of its assets in cash and global bonds in order to protect returns when the investment manager believes stock markets are expected to be particularly weak. The fund typically holds 40- 60 positions. The fund may invest in money market instruments and hold cash.

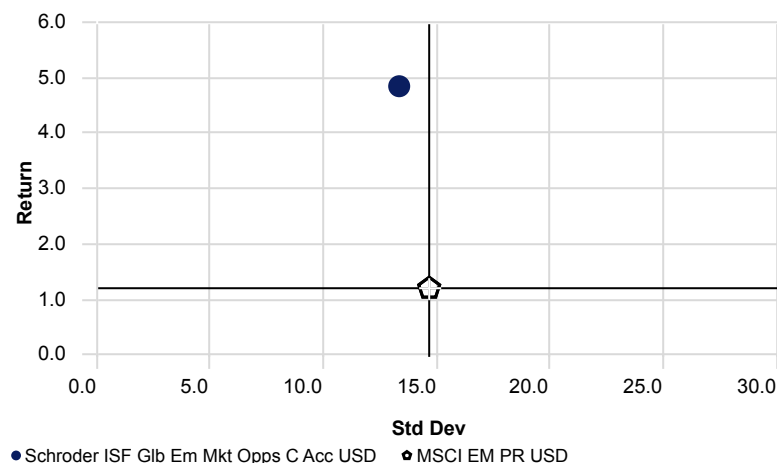

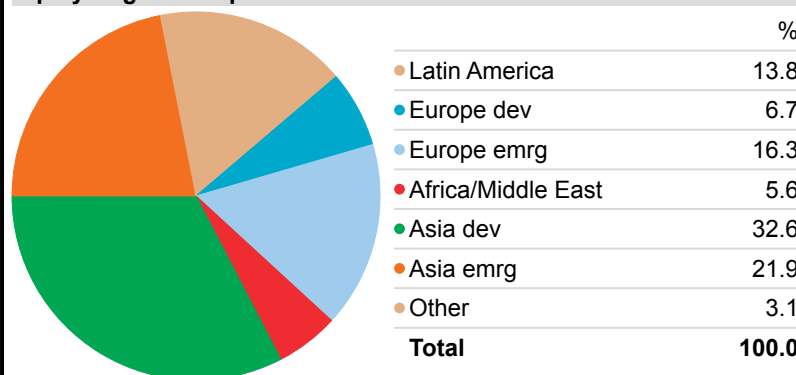
